Program Overview

As of January 2016, all <u>HonorSociety.org</u> chapters will be required to participate in the Leadership, Values and Benefits Program (LVBP). Each month, the chapter board members will train its members on leadership skills and the values and benefits of <u>HonorSociety.org</u>.

Trainings
